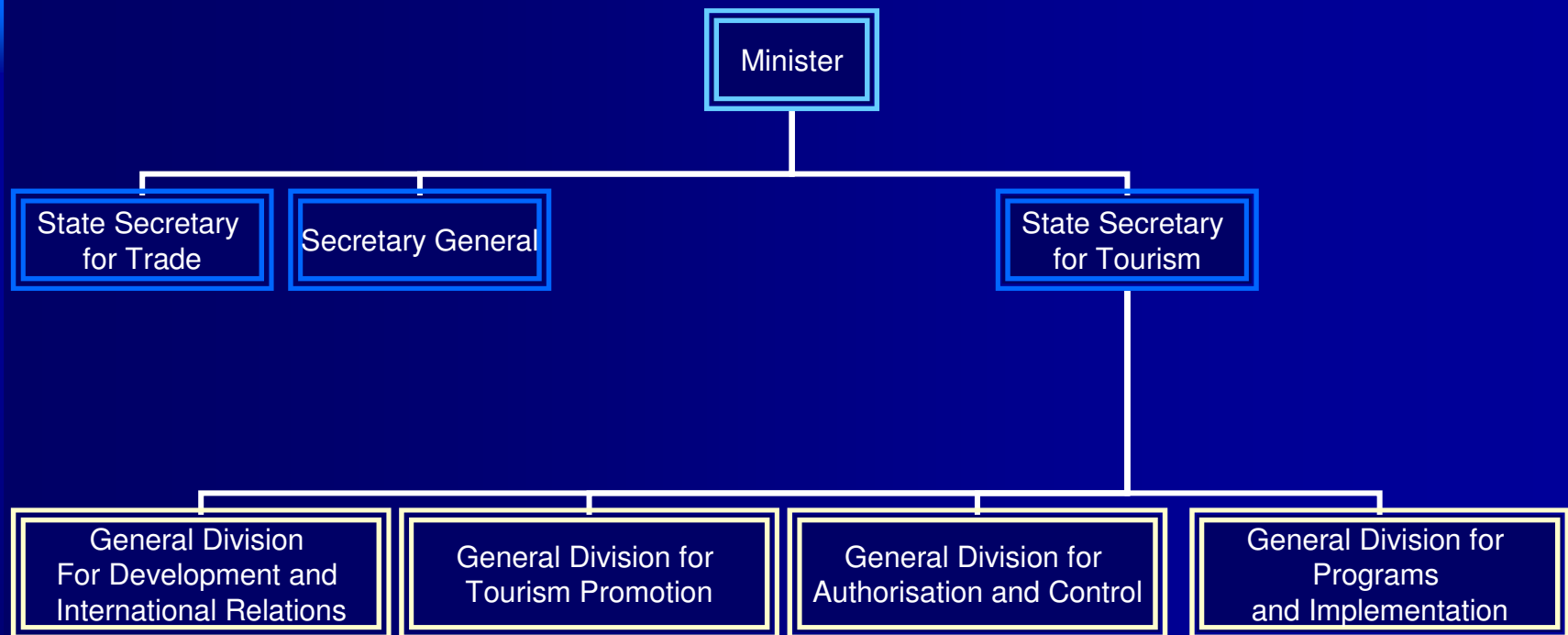

- Promotion of Romania as a tourism destination, etc.

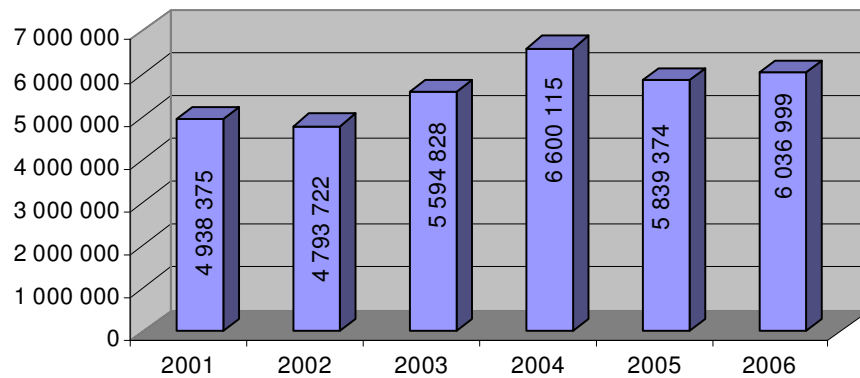
# Map of the national tourism offices in Europe



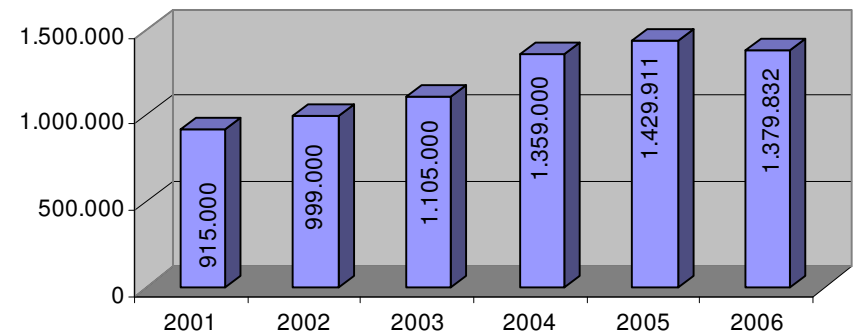

**Arrivals of foreign visitors at the Romanian borders**



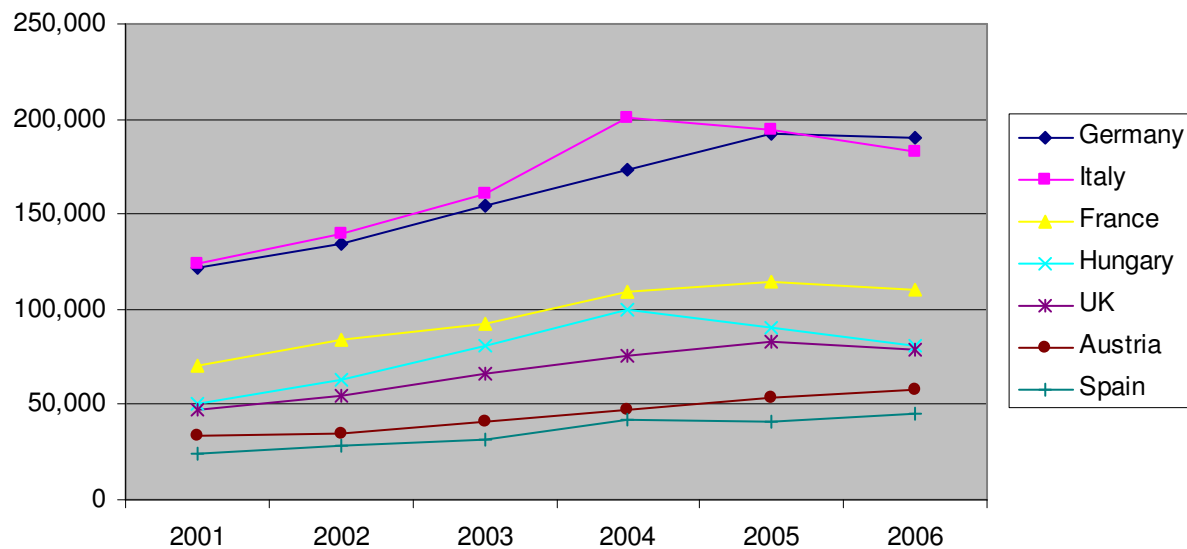
**Arrivals of foreign citizens in all accommodation facilities**

2001-2006



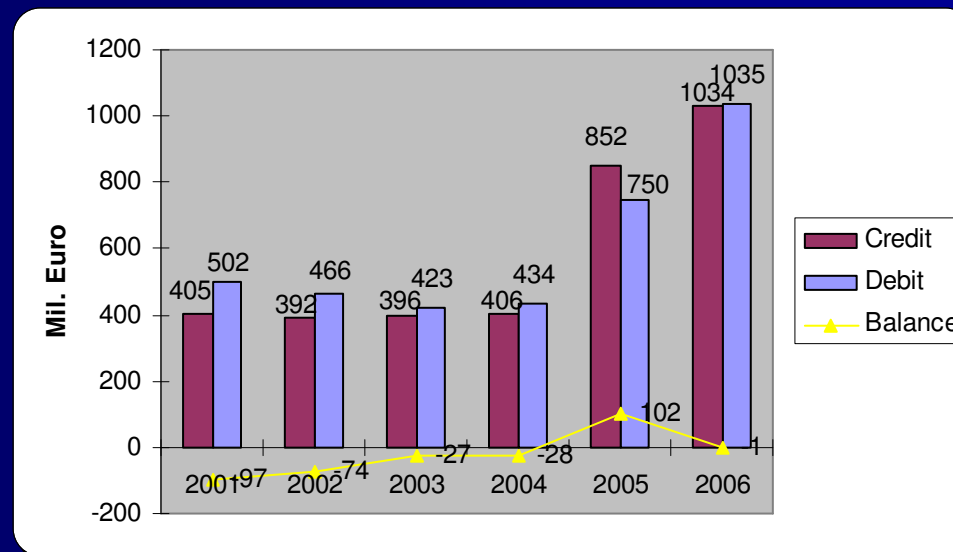

## International tourism receipts

The tourism balance became positive in 2005, after a long period of negative results. The incomes doubled in 2005 in comparison with 2004. In 2006, the incomes surpassed the level of EUR 1 billion for the first time, the balance being slightly negative.

Changes in international tourism receipts and expenditures

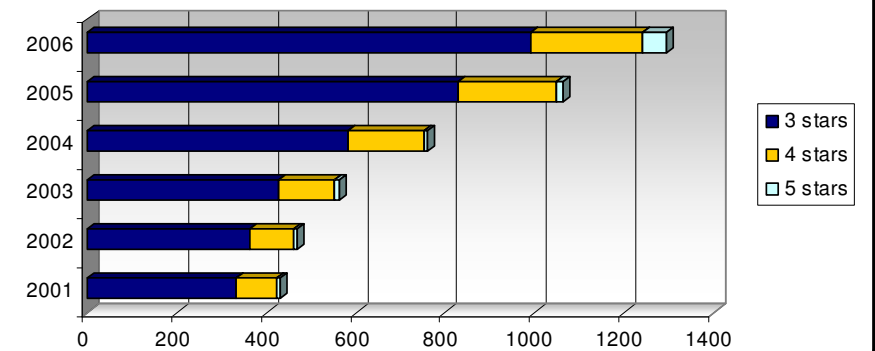
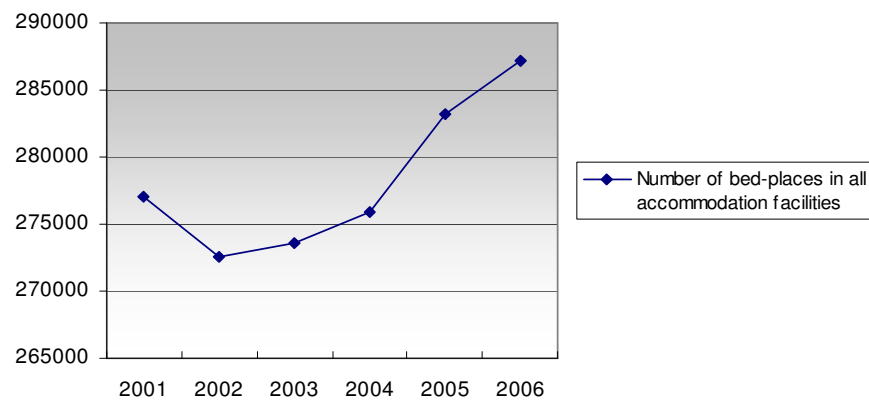
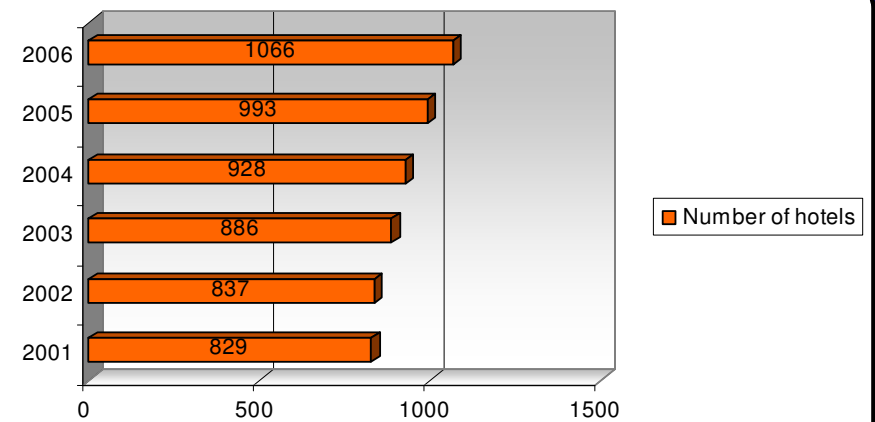
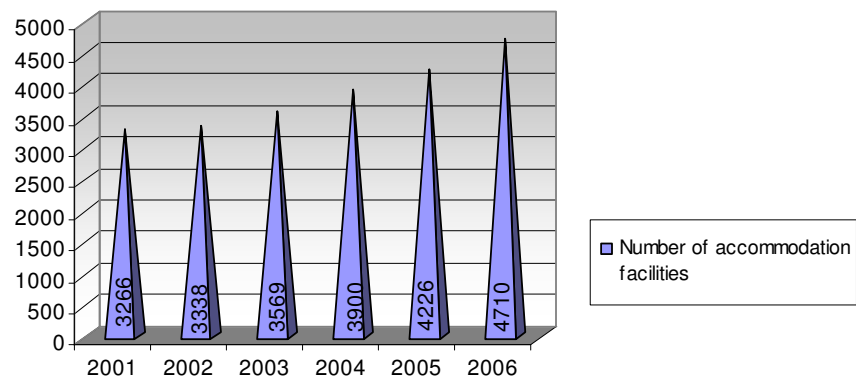

Debit – tourism expenditure in other countries

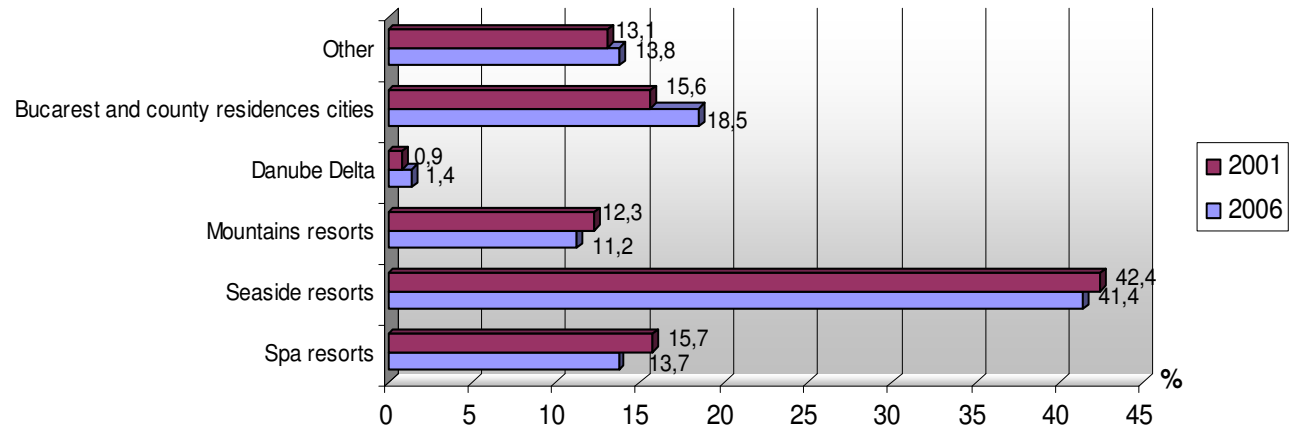

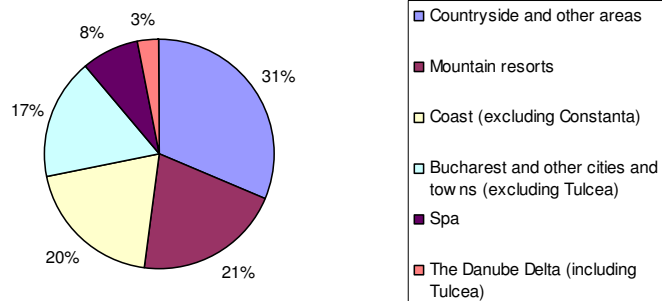

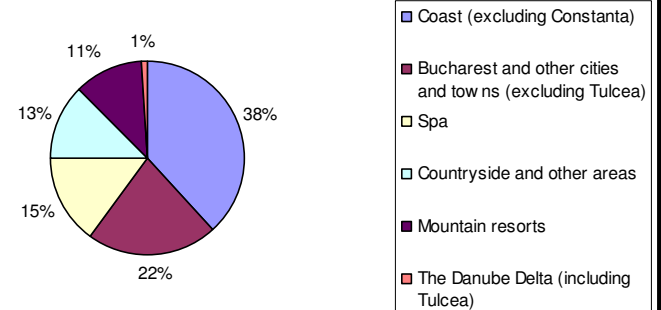
### Evolution of the bed-places (2001-2006)



### Location of the accommodation units

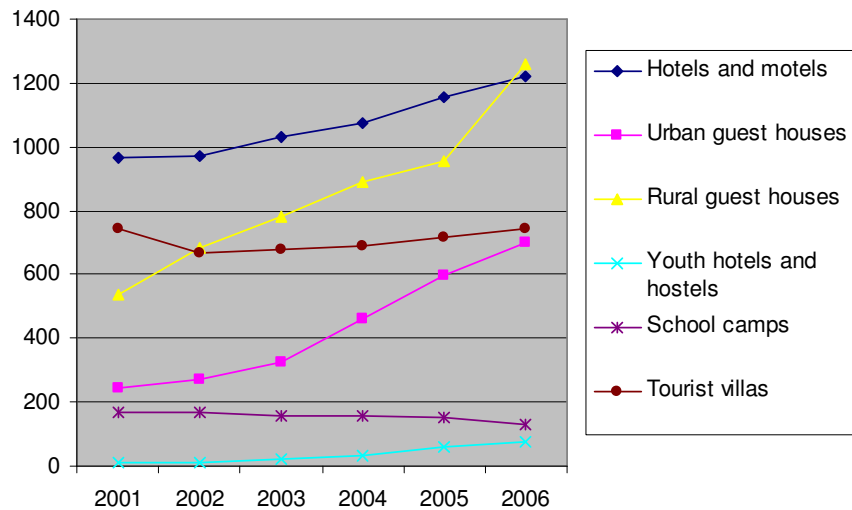


### Distribution of rooms

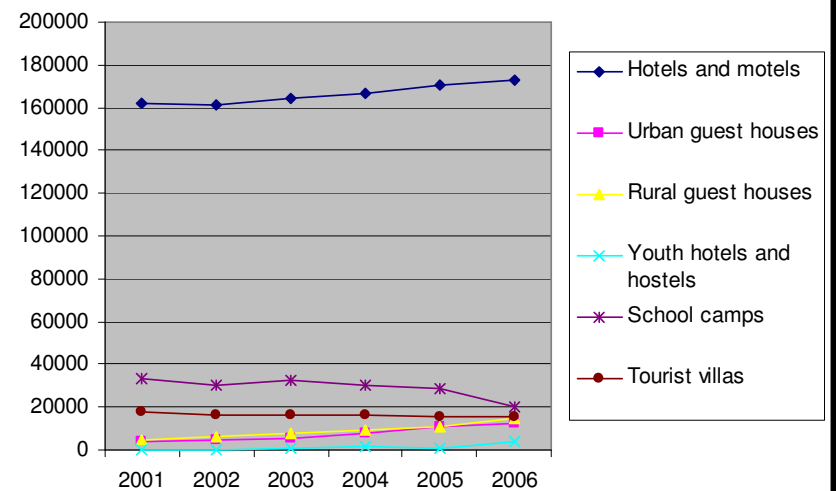
